DIRECTIONS

BEST WESTERN, POTTSTOWN

Exit 24 PA Turnpike to US 202 South to US 422 West to Armand Hammer Boulevard Exit.
Left at the end of the ramp and an immediate left to the motel.

HOLIDAY INN EXPRESS, KING OF PRUSSIA

FROM THE PA TURNPIKE (I-76) - use exit #24 and take the Rt. 202 North, third exit about ½ mile from toll booth. Get into the left lane, 202 will split with the left lane turning left onto North Gulph Road. Proceed on N. Gulph through two lights. The entrance to the Holiday Inn Express is just past the King of Prussia Diner (might be closed) and Ruth's Chris Steak House on the right.

FROM I-95 NORTH - Take I-95 N to I-476, which is just past Chester, PA. Take I-476 about 15 miles to I-76. Take I-76 West about 4 miles stay to the right when you're approaching King of Prussia. Once in the right chute get into the left lane, you will pass the exits for Rt. 202 North, then 202 South/422 West, once past the second exit stay to the right when the road splits (the left fork goes to the PA Turnpike the right fork goes to Exit 327 - Mall Blvd. The ramp goes directly to Mall Blvd make the right and go a couple hundred feet and make a right onto Pulaski Dr. (at the sign for The Children Hospital Specialty Care Center) to the entrance for the Holiday Inn Express.

THURSDAY NIGHT GATHERING – at Walt (WA3PPW) & Donna's.

The Thursday evening gathering at Walt (WA3PPW) and Donna's home in King of Prussia is scheduled from 7:00 PM till 10:00 PM.

FROM THE BEST WESTERN IN POTTSTOWN – take US 422 EAST and exit at the Rt. 23/VF National Park exit (about 20 miles). Turn left at the end of the ramp (this is Rt. 23 East). Go east on 23 to the second light(Geerdes Blvd) turn left, about one block, turn right at the first light, you are still on 23 (now Valley Forge Rd.), go two lights, Henderson Road, and make a left onto Henderson Road, go down the hill about 3 blocks and there will be a large Rooster on the right, go one block and turn left onto Robin Road, go to the dead-end,

one short block, and turn right onto Hidden Valley Road we are the fifth house on the right, 677 Hidden Valley Road. The phone number is 610-337-2198

FROM THE HOLIDAY INN EXPRESS IN KING OF PRUSSIA - turn right onto N. Gulph Rd. At the seventh light turn right onto Rt. 23 East, go east on 23 to the third light. Stay on 23, turn left to next light, about one block, turn right at the light, you are still on 23, go two lights, Henderson Road, and make a left onto Henderson Road, go down the hill about 3 blocks and there will be a large Rooster on the right, go one block and turn left onto Robin Road, go to the dead-end, one short block, and turn right onto Hidden Valley Road we are the fifth house on the right, 677 Hidden Valley Road. The phone number is 610-337-2198.

SPRING HOLLOW GOLF CLUB

>From Pottstown Best Western

At the end of motel driveway, turn Right onto Yost Rd. (not marked). Make next Right onto US 422 Ramp and stay Right for US 422 West. Take the next exit, PA 724, Phoenixville, it comes up immediately. Turn Left at end of ramp onto Rt. 724 East. Proceed on Rt. 724 for 4.2 miles. The course entrance is on the Right and is somewhat hidden. If you get to the Wawa & traffic light, you have gone too far.

>From King of Prussia & Schuylkill Expressway

Exit Rt. 202 South. Follow 202 for 1/4 mile, exit onto US 422 (West). Proceed about 20 miles to the PA 724, Phoenixville Exit (milepost 173.3). Turn Left at end of ramp onto Rt. 724 East. Proceed on Rt. 724 for 4.2 miles. The course entrance is on the Right and is somewhat hidden. If you get to the Wawa & traffic light, you have gone too far.

>From Pa. Turnpike

Exit the Turnpike at Valley Forge Exit #24, onto US 202 South. Take the US 422 West ramp. Proceed about 20 miles to the PA 724, Phoenixville Exit (milepost 173.3). Turn Left at end of ramp onto Rt. 724 East. Proceed on Rt. 724 for 4.2 miles. The course entrance is on the Right and is somewhat hidden. If you get to the Wawa & traffic light, you have gone too far.

>From the West

Get on US 422 East. Exit US 422 at the PA 724, Phoenixville Exit (milepost 173.3). Turn Left at end of ramp onto Rt. 724 East. Proceed on Rt. 724 for 4.2 miles. The course entrance is on the Right and is somewhat hidden. If you get to the Wawa & traffic light, you have gone too far.

Jim K3CHJ's and Dotty's home

Reference Point - Armand Hammer Blvd. Exit is about 2 miles east of the Route 422 & Route 100 interchange near Pottstown.

Follow US 422 to exit labeled Armand Hammer Blvd at approximately mile marker 174. (*EB – turn right at end of ramp. WB turn right at end of ramp and left at light.*) Follow Armand Hammer Blvd north to High Street light and turn right (*Wendy's on the left after turn*). Continue on High Street past the hospital and turn left at light onto Sunnybrook Road (*CVS Pharmacy on the corner*). Turn right at the stop sign onto Kepler Road (*right turn keep moving sign*), travel a short distance and turn right onto Brookwood Drive. Continue to the top of the hill to 1037 Brookwood Drive. Jim has a triband and tower next to the house. Phone is 610-326-7324 & GPS coordinates are N40 14.966, W75 36.310.

ROOSTER PICNIC

Saturday's picnic will be held in St. Michael Park, Jacob St., Mont Clare, PA. This is on the Schuylkill Canal and is a beautiful setting.

For you GPS types, the coordinates are 40° 08' 27.9" N and 75° 30' 30.7" W. For the rest of us, here are the directions (sent by Jim K3JJC):

>From Montgomery County:

Heading east on PA Route 422 Bypass:

Take 422 East to the Phoenixville/Collegeville exit. At the bottom of the exit ramp go to the right, which will put you on Route 29 South. Follow Route 29 South for approximately 3 miles to Mont Clare and the traffic light at Produce Junction. Turn right at this light (Jacob Street) follow to the end at the park (about a quarter mile).

Heading south on PA Route 29 from the Collegeville area:

Follow Route 29 South to Mont Clare and the traffic light at Produce Junction. Turn right at this light (Jacob Street) follow to the end at the park (about a quarter mile).

Heading west on PA Route 422 Bypass:

Take 422 West to the Collegeville/Phoenixville exit. At the bottom of the exit ramp make a left on to PA Route 29 South. Follow Route 29 South for approximately 3 miles to Mont Clare and the traffic light at Produce Junction. Turn right at this light (Jacob Street) follow to the end at the park (about a quarter mile).

OR: Take PA Route 422 West to the Oaks exit. At the bottom of the exit ramp make a left on to Egypt Road heading west. Proceed on Egypt Road through the village of Oaks into Mont Clare. Make a left turn at the blinking light on to Route 29 South. Proceed about 1/2 mile to Jacob Street and turn right to follow it a short distance into St Michael Park.... (Hey, Hey.... You've arrived!)

>From Chester County:

Heading north on PA Route 29

Pick-up PA Route 29 North as you travel through Phoenixville. Cross the Schuylkill River on the bridge leading from Phoenixville to Mont Clare. Turn left at the first light in Mont Clare after you come off of the bridge.

>From Valley Forge, King of Prussia, and the east.

Take PA Route 23 west from Valley Forge into Phoenixville. Turn right at second traffic light (Starr St. - Getty gas station on corner). Follow this about 8 blocks to the second traffic light (at a Tee intersection - Bridge St.). Turn right and cross the bridge into Mont Clare. After coming off of the bridge, turn left at the first traffic light (Jacob Street), follow to the park at the end (about a quarter mile).
